<p><b>CORPORATE PRIORITY/POLICY CONTEXT:</b></p> <p>In December 2015, the NHS shared planning guidance for the period 16/17 – 20/21 outlined a new approach to help ensure that health and care services are built around the needs of local populations. To do this, every health and care system in England had to produce a multi-year Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP), showing how local services will evolve and become sustainable over the next five years – ultimately delivering the Five Year Forward View vision of better health, better patient care and improved NHS efficiency.</p> <p>To deliver plans that are based on the needs of local populations, local health and care systems came together in January 2016 to form 44 STP ‘footprints’. Croydon is part of the SWL footprint/sub region and we have been working together with the other 6 local authorities and the STP Programme Office currently based in Merton CCG to develop our STP. The SWL STP has been published on Friday 21 October 2016. In order to maximise the Adult Social Care input into the SWL STP, the six Directors of Adult Social Care (DASSs) worked during the summer on a programme with key workstreams (attached). The six Councils involved have also agreed to jointly fund a programme director who will coordinate these work streams and provide the wider programme management and interface into the development and implementation of the SWL STP.</p> <p>The Outcome Based Commissioning model for the over 65s already provides a strong foundation for the Council to build our local joint plans going forward.</p>
