

## **APPENDIX E**

**Applicant:** Alberto Santini

**Location:** On the footway outside Norwood Junction Station, Clifford Road South Norwood SE25

**Measurements:** The Coffee van is situated 16.6m from the entrance to the station.  
The measurement from the wall to the edge of the pavement is 5m narrowing down to 4m  
The applicant has applied for a trading area of 1.45 width which leaves a clear pavement width of 3.55 m narrowing to 2.55 m. Clifford Road is maintained by Croydon Council and the minimum clear pavement width required is 2 m. A total display length of 3.2m and height of 2.1 m are also applied for.

### **1. Detailed Considerations**

- 1.1 The application was received by the Place Department on 9 June 2015  
A copy of the application is attached as Appendix E4.
- 1.2 The application was duly advertised in the Croydon Guardian, 2 objections were received these are attached as Appendix E5.
- 1.3 The applicant has submitted 24 emails etc documents in support of the application, these are attached as Appendix E6.  
In addition the applicant has submitted copies of entries from social media websites i.e Facebook and Twitter in support of the application.
- 1.4 The Police licensing Officers, Food Safety team, Planning, Highways, and parking services divisions were invited to comment on this application, no objections have been received.
- 1.5 The measurements outlined above have been checked and agreed by an Enforcement Officer during a site visit.

- 1.6 A temporary licence was issued to the applicant which is valid until the 9.12.2015 pending the committee's decision. A copy is attached as Appendix E7.
- 1.7 There is 1 other nearby premises in Clifford Road who currently holds a street trading licence no 2-4, fruit and vegetables. This site is marked with a \* and the site applied for is shaded on the attached map Appendix E8
- 1.8 If the application for a street designation order is granted the applicant will be invited to apply for a Street Trading Licence which will then be valid for a year
- 1.9 Would the Committee please note that the applicant has provided 2 ramps to enable the van to drive onto the pavement as shown in Appendix E10
