**A49/15 LICENSING ACT 2003 – APPLICATION FOR INTERIM STEPS  
PENDING A REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCE: SHISHA QUI, 20  
HIGH STREET, PURLEY CR8 2AA**

In respect of Shisha Qui, 20 High Street, Purley CR8 2AA, the Licensing Sub-Committee considered information circulated by the Licensing Manager including:

- A copy of the application including a copy of the relevant certificate signed by a Police Superintendent
- A copy of the premises licence for the premises licence holder - Mr. Elafany Ahmed
- A copy of a Home Office guidance document on summary reviews.

The Council, as licensing authority, has to determine a review of the premises licence within 28 days of the application being made. On receipt of the application however the licensing Sub-Committee has 48 hours to decide whether to take any interim steps pending the full review hearing.

The options open to the Licensing Sub-Committee include:

- Modification of the conditions of the premises licence
- The exclusion of the sale by retail of alcohol from the scope of the licence
- Removal of the designated premises supervisor from the licence
- Suspension of the licence

The Licensing Sub-Committee, having considered the information provided, **RESOLVED** to suspend the following licensable activities authorised by the licence:

- The sale of retail of alcohol – on the premises
- The provision of regulated entertainment namely:

Anything of a similar description to that falling within e) live music, f) recorded music, or g) performances of dance

The Licensing Sub-Committee was content for the premises licence in respect of the provision of late night refreshment to remain in place on the provision that this takes place from the takeaway at the front of the premises.
