Applicant: Benedict Selvaratnam

Location: On the footway outside 86-88 Church Street Croydon Surrey
CR0 1RB

Measurements: The total measurement from the shop window to the edge of the kerb is 3.1m
The applicant has applied for a trading area of 0.7m to the left of the entrance door.
This leaves a clear pavement width of 2.4 m.
Church street is maintained by Croydon Council and the minimum required clear pavement width is 2 m.
The applicant has applied to display goods on the total length to the left hand side of the entrance door of 7m, but is currently only displaying to a length of 1.2 m as seen in photographs B2 and B3.
A height of 2m is also applied for.

Appendices B2 and B3 are photographs of the display.

Proposed Times of Trading:

Monday to Sunday 0800 hours until 2200 hours

To Display: Flowers, compost and seasonal vegetables

1. Detailed Considerations

- 1.1 The application was received by the Place Department on 11 November 2015
A copy of the application is attached as Appendix B4.
- 1.2 The application was duly advertised in the Croydon Guardian, no objections were received.
- 1.3 The Police licensing Officers, Food Safety team, Planning, Highways and parking services divisions were invited to comment on this application, no objections have been received.
- 1.4 The measurements outlined above have been checked and agreed by an Enforcement Officer during a site visit.
- 1.5 A temporary licence was issued to the applicant which is valid until the 22.4.2016 pending the committee's decision. A copy is attached as Appendix B5.
- 1.6 There are 3 other nearby premises who currently hold street trading licences, no 76-80 – furniture, household goods and travel accessories, 92 –

households goods and 98 – tables and chairs. These sites are marked with an x and the site applied for is shaded on the attached map Appendix B6

- 1.7 If the application for a street designation order is granted the applicant will be invited to apply for a Street Trading Licence which will then be valid for a year
