edge of the pavement is 2.6m. The applicant has applied for a

trading area of 0.6m either side of the entrance door. This leaves a clear pavement width of 2 m, this part of London Road is maintained by Croydon Council and the

required clear pavement width is 2 m.

A length of 2m to the left of the entrance door and 3.6 m to the

right of the entrance door is also applied for.

## 1. Detailed Considerations

1.1 The application was received by the Place Department on 14 October 2015.

A copy of the application is attached as Appendix D4.

- 1.2 The application was duly advertised in the Croydon Guardian, no objections were received.
- 1.3 The Police licensing Officers, Food Safety team, Planning, Highways and Parking Services divisions were invited to comment on this application, no objections have been received.
- 1.4 The applicant was advised by letter that as this site is on London Road and in accordance with Council Policy the Committee will generally be minded to refuse any further requests for designation, due to 'additional sites would have a detrimental impact on the safe and convenient passage of pedestrians in that part of the street', but will consider each request on its merits. A copy of the letter is attached as Appendix D5.
- 1.5 The measurements outlined above have been checked and agreed by an Enforcement Officer during a site visit.

- 1.6 A temporary licence was issued to the applicant which is valid until the 14.4.2016 pending the committee's decision. A copy is attached as Appendix D6.
- 1.7 There are no other nearby premises in London Road who currently hold a street trading licence.
  The site applied for is shaded on the attached map Appendix D7.
- 1.8 If the application for a street designation order is granted the applicant will be invited to apply for a Street Trading Licence which will then be valid for a year.
