Applicant: Paul Duncan

Location: On the footway outside 33 Central Parade Croydon Surrey
CR0 0JD

Measurements: The measurement from the shop window to the edge of the kerb is 4.5 m
The applicant has applied for 2 display areas.
LHS – Width 1.5 m and length 1.6m
RHS - Width 1.5 and length 1.5 m.
These widths includes room for staff to move freely inside the barrier which encloses the display

This leaves a clear pavement width of 3m on each side
Central Parade is maintained by Croydon Council and the minimum required clear pavement width is 2 m.

Appendices C2 and C3 are photographs of the display.

1. Detailed Considerations

- 1.1 The application was received by the Place Department on 9 August 2016.
A copy of the application is attached as Appendix C4.
- 1.2 The application was duly advertised in the Croydon Guardian, no objections were received.
- 1.3 The Police licensing Officers, Food Safety team, Planning, Highways , and parking services divisions were invited to comment on this application, no objections have been received.
- 1.4 The measurements outlined above have been checked and agreed by an Enforcement Officer during a site visit.
- 1.5 A temporary licence was issued to the applicant which is valid until the 17.2.2017 pending the committee's decision. A copy is attached as Appendix C5.

- 1.6 There are 2 other nearby premises who currently hold a street trading licences, no 24 – pet and garden supplies and no 38 – tables and chairs. These sites are marked with an x and the site applied for is shaded on the attached map Appendix C6
- 1.7 If the application for a street designation order is granted the applicant will be invited to apply for a Street Trading Licence which will then be valid for a year
