

## Appendix 2: HWBB Workshop 5th December 2018: Overarching Themes and priority actions

### Three overarching themes were identified:

- **Pathways.** Navigate through the system with the right access, receiving the right service at the right time in the right place
- **Engage** with children, young people, their families, carers and communities
- **Strategic Join Up and Wider work:** maximise the resilience of the population through working with non-MH services, providing information, and through improving wider determinants such as housing,
