



Proposed Conditions for Zen Lounge, Cappella Court, 725 Brighton Road, Croydon, CR8 2PG.

The premises licence holder shall ensure –

- A closed circuit television system is installed at the premises with cameras located within the premises to cover all public areas including all entrances and capable of obtaining clear facial recognition images and a clear head and shoulders image of every person entering or leaving the premises. Images must be securely retained for a minimum of 31 days. In addition —
 - That the CCTV system is operating and recording 24 hours every day (motion sensitive equipment is acceptable to reduce storage of images).
 - b. All equipment must have a constant and accurate time and date generation.
 - c. There are members of trained staff at the premises during operating hours able to provide viewable copies on request to police or authorised local authority officers as soon as is reasonably practicable in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.
- 2. Ensure that a comprehensive incident register is maintained, at the premises. The DPS shall ensure that details of incidents shall be added to the register within 24hrs of any incident. The following details shall be recorded:
 - a. Date
 - b. Time
 - c. Location
 - d. Persons concerned
 - e. Summary of incident
 - f. Identification of any Emergency Services Personnel who attended.
- All staff are trained in the relevant sections of the Licensing Act 2003, including the licensing objectives, and conflict management. The training will be refreshed every 6 months and all staff training records should be maintained and kept on site
- 4. Signs shall be clearly displayed at exits/entry points asking patrons to leave quietly.

Due to premises being close proximity to residential properties, the Pollution team is minded to require mitigation measures and conditions to the licence to address any potential noise impact on local residents.

Conditions/Restrictions

This will be a format which will be easily embedded and enforceable if there are future problems.

- 1. The licensee will ensure that a noise limiter is installed to control any recorded music. The limiter to be set a reasonable level by the pollution team.
- 2. Any music is confined to indoors and should not be audible from outside the premises
- 3. The licensee will ensure that there is no external music played at the premises.
- 4. The licensee will ensure that doors and windows are kept closed during events involving live and recorded music, including the appropriate use of lobby doors.
- 5. The licensee will ensure that patrons are managed to ensure that noise from exiting and entering is kept to minimum.
- 6. The licensee will ensure that there is close and regular liaison with the residents within close proximity of the premises to address complaints and concerns.
- 7. The licensee will ensure that no noise nuisance be caused to local residents from any activity associated with the premises licence

We have a long running series of complaints against Zen lounge from local residents disturbed by the music, the engine noise from many vehicles late at night and the smoke impact from their terrace.

There have been complaints of a public nuisance from this venue. The noise is a public nuisance, both from the music but also from the many vehicles parked outside. They disturb neighbours late at night and will continue to do so at 2.30am, both in the venue and when leaving and the smoking is a nuisance to neighbours from the terrace.


